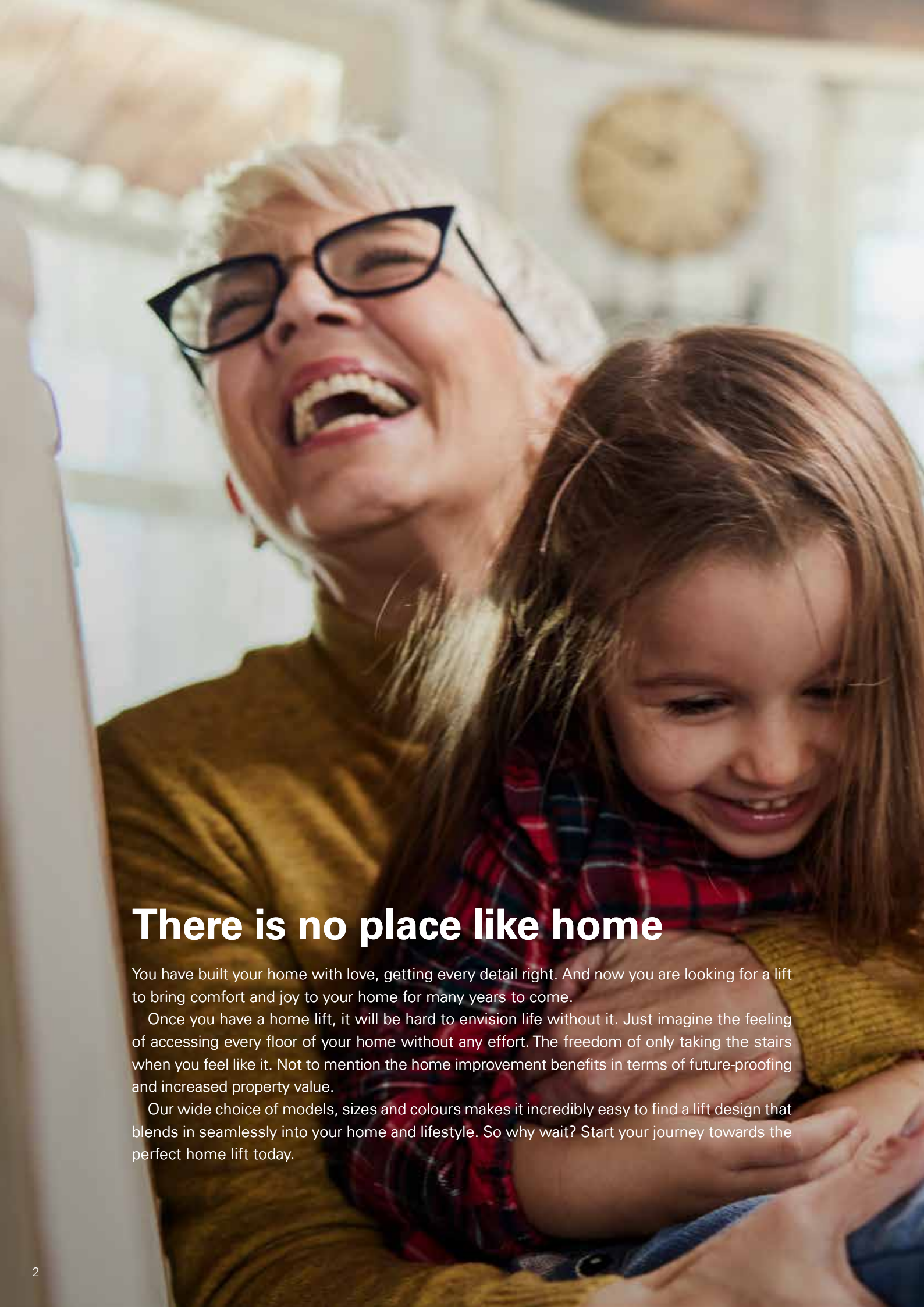

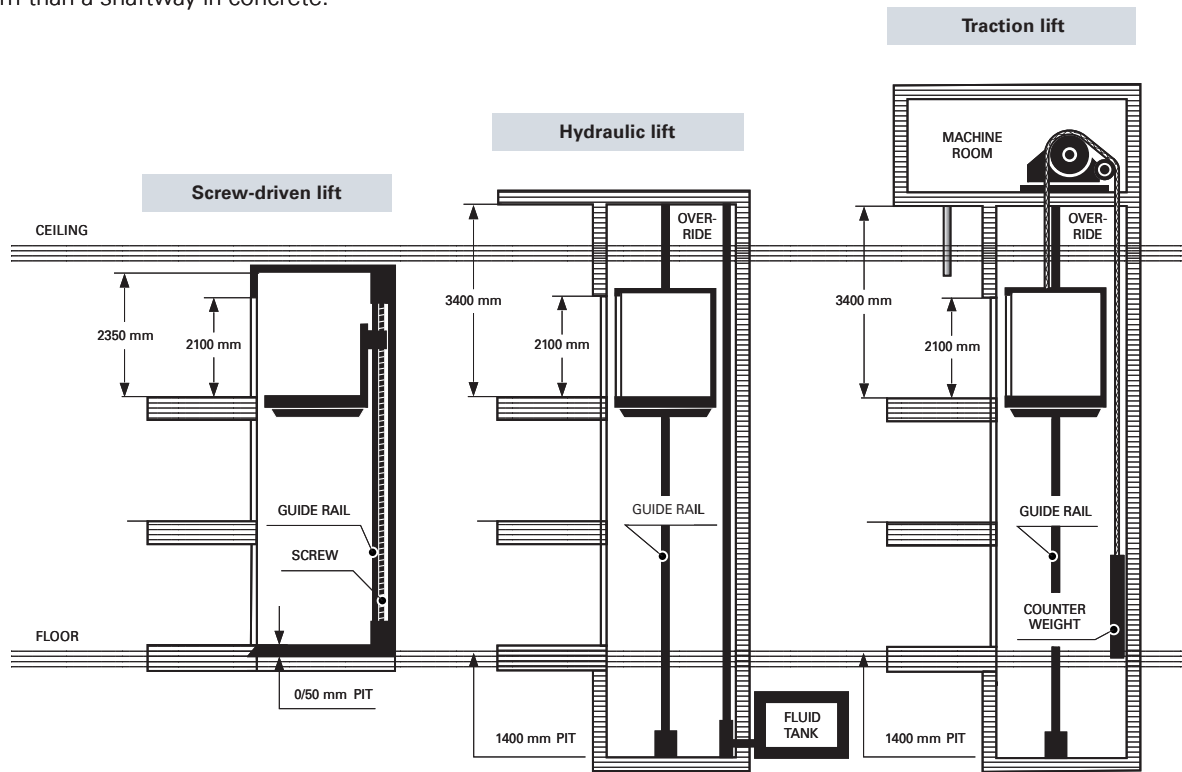

Space-saving concept

Our home lifts are much more space-efficient than conventional residential elevators (see hydraulic lift and traction lift in the image below). Whereas the machinery of conventional elevators requires you to dig out a deep lift pit and open the ceiling on the top floor, our screw-driven machinery is compact enough to fit inside the lift. In addition, we deliver our lifts with a ready-made lift shaft that takes up much less room than a shaftway in concrete.



Unlike conventional elevators, Cibes screw-driven lifts do not require a lot of space above and beneath the elevator.

Sustainable modular solutions

As part of our efforts to increase manufacturing efficiency and minimise waste, all our lifts are made of standardised modules. Our modular approach also makes it possible to deliver our lifts in space-efficient flatpacks to reduce our carbon footprint even further.

Fast and easy installation

Whereas most conventional elevators take several weeks to install, our space-saving, modular home lifts can be installed with minimal building work in just a few days.



Small home lifts

Do you have 1 m² to spare? Then you have enough room to install one of our home lifts. Our smallest lift platform size 625 x 950 mm (w x d) only takes up as much space as a standard wardrobe.

Pitless home lifts

It is possible to install your home lift directly on the floor, without a pit. Pitless lift installation reduces your building costs and preserves the structural integrity of your home. Pitless home lifts are delivered with a ready-made access ramp for the bottom floor.

What is the best place for your lift?

Our lifts offer you many different options for installation and the solution that first comes to mind may not be the only one. That is why we want to share examples of some of our most common installation scenarios with you.



Through-the-floor installation

This is a very common type of lift installation that makes your home lift pass through openings between the floors. A professional builder needs to create the floor openings.



In the middle of the staircase

Stairwell installation is another popular choice. This is a space-saving solution that requires much less building work than through-the-floor installation, for example.



Against a mezzanine floor

This type of installation requires very little building work but demands great attention to detail and design as your lift tends to become the main focal point of the room.



Inside a shaftway

If you are looking for a discreet solution that really blends in, installing your home lift in a shaftway is a great option. A professional builder needs to create the shaftway.

Great use of your staircase

Thanks to our compact lift concept, it is possible to install your home lift in very limited and narrow spaces. A lift installed in an interior staircase is a great way to capitalise on an often unused space.

Press the button once to call the lift

To call your platform lift to the floor, just press the button once.

Maintain pressure on the button to travel

Travelling with our platform lifts is safe and easy. As long as you apply pressure on the floor button, the lift travels, as soon as you let go, it stops.

Panoramic glazing

One of the most unique features of our platform lifts is the panoramic lift shaft. All 4 sides of the shaft can be glazed, including the machinery side. Our latest generation of lifts has super thin glass panel frames and comes with elegant panoramic doors to enhance the light and airy impression.

In addition, the modular concept behind our new generation of lifts makes it easier to update and upgrade your lift over time to maximise product lifetime.



Door alternatives

Beams, pillars and doorways are elements that create the unique character of your home, but they can also get in the way of an opening lift door. Our flexible and smart door design can avoid those obstacles. For example, the doors of platform lifts Cibes A4000, Cibes Air and Cibes Cloud Plus can be placed on all sides of the shaft except on the side where the screw-driven lift machinery is placed. It is also possible to choose the hinge-side of the doors so that it works with the layout of your home.

Full-height doors

Our standard, full-height doors have a door clearance height of 2.0-2.1 metres and will fit under most ceilings, but every home is different. That is why we offer doors with customisable door height. For the Cibes Cloud Plus, we also provide double-hinged, elegant saloon doors.



Gate on the top floor

For platform lifts Cibes A4000, Cibes Air and Cibes Cloud Plus, you have the option of choosing a 1.1–1.3-metre-high gate* on the top floor. A gate is a great choice for rooms with sloped or low ceilings, but also if you just want to keep your top floor open and airy.

*In Europe, gates are available for lifts with a travel of maximum 3 metres.



Home lifts with premium comfort

Just like our platform lifts, cabin lift Cibes C1 Pure has a space-efficient and compact construction, but it looks and feels a lot more like a conventional elevator. The timeless design includes automatic sliding doors and one-touch controls both inside and outside the lift. This is the only screw-driven lift in the world to offer this level of comfort.

Space-saving design

The screw-driven machinery of our cabin lifts requires almost no space above or beneath the lift. All you need is a 10 cm pit and a top floor headroom of 2.5 metres.

Our automatic sliding doors have a sleek and modern design and are available with door panels in glass or steel to blend in perfectly into your unique interior design.

One-touch controls

Reach all the floors of your home by one single push of the button. The Cibes C1 Pure is designed to offer you a travel experience with the highest level of comfort.

How to find the perfect lift for you

Wheelchair home lift

If your residential lift needs to accommodate a wheelchair, getting a big enough lift size is key. We recommend a platform size of at least 1025 x 1350 mm and a cabin size of at least 1100 x 1200 mm (w x d), but these are general recommendations that apply to most manual wheelchairs. Please contact your local Cibes dealer for more specific advice.

Home lift for enhanced comfort

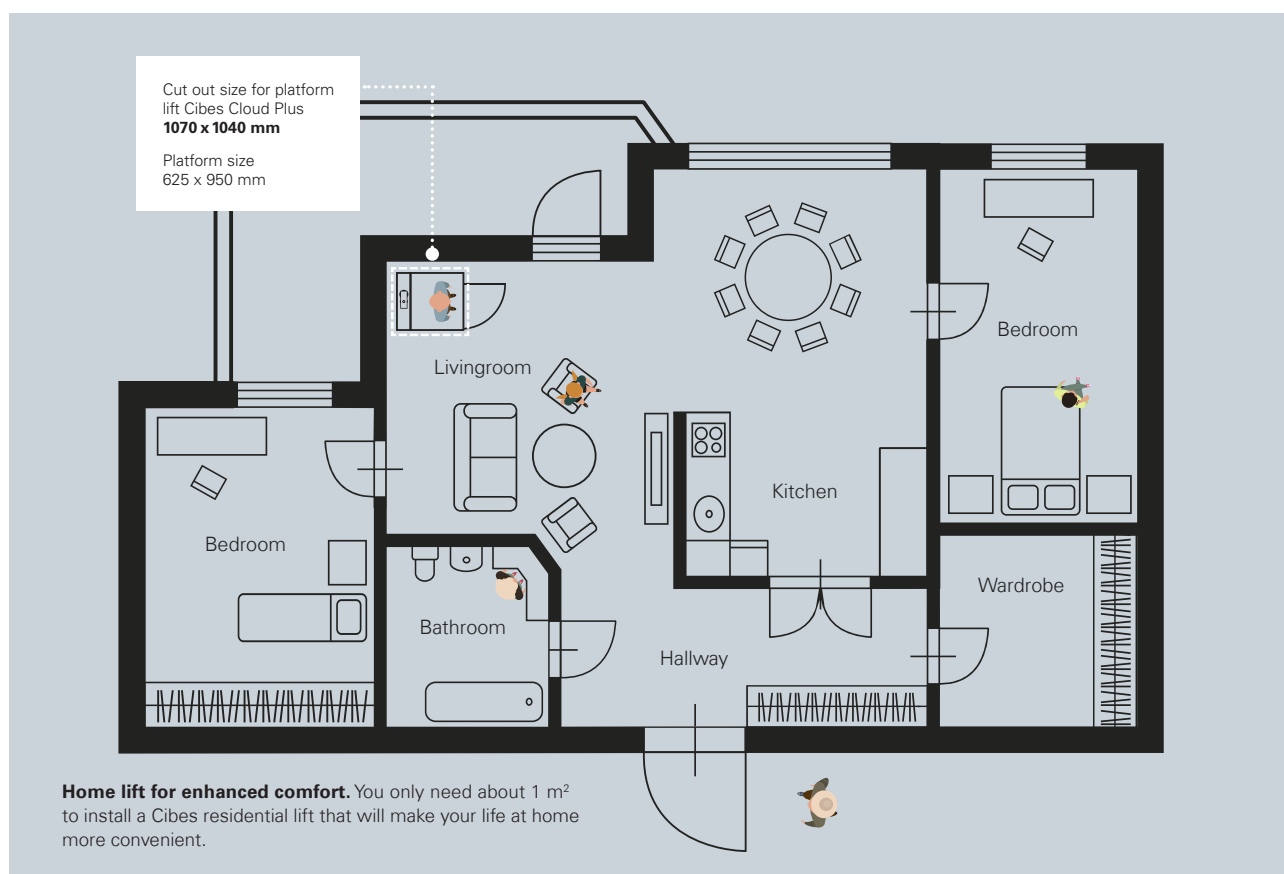
If on the other hand you are looking for a lift to enhance your comfort at home, you can go as small as you want. However, it all comes down to your needs. Our smallest lift sizes are suitable for 1–2 standing passengers. If you need the lift to take more passengers or accommodate people with mobility issues, you should opt for a bigger size.

Ideal for existing homes

Thanks to our space-saving, ready-made concept, installing a Cibes lift in an existing home is much faster and easier than installing a conventional lift. While a conventional lift requires extensive building work, installing one of our lifts has almost no structural impact on your home. In addition, most of our lift models include a modular shaft so that you do not need to hire a construction company to build one.

Advantages for new-built homes

If you are building a new home, a residential lift by Cibes is much easier to fit into your planning than a conventional elevator. Our home lifts are delivered in ready-made elements and only take a few days to install. In addition, our lifts require much fewer and less extensive building preparations than conventional elevators.



Lifts for outdoor living

If you are struggling to find a good place for a lift inside your home, why not look for the perfect place outdoors? Our outdoor lift concept is one of the best ones in the market and will adapt to almost any architectural style and climate.

Weather resistant wheelchair lifts

Our outdoor lifts are equipped to handle temperatures between -10° C and +30° C as well as snow and rain. Available in 2 platform sizes – 1000x1467 and 1100x1467 mm – our outdoor lifts are big enough for 4–5 passengers and wheelchair users.

Your Cibes dealer will handle the lift installation, directly or through a certified partner to make sure that your lift is installed correctly and complies with our safety protocols.

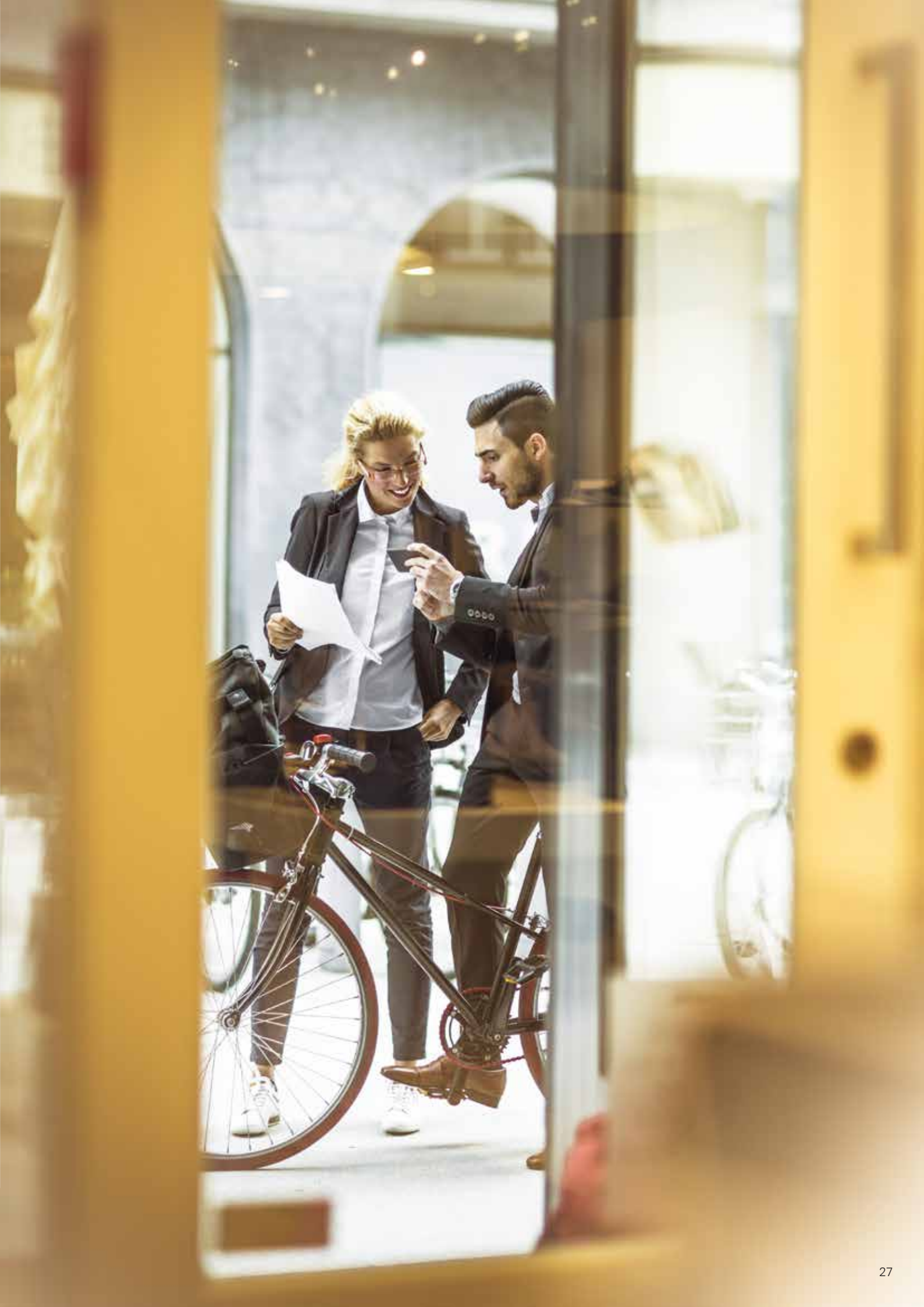


Service & maintenance
